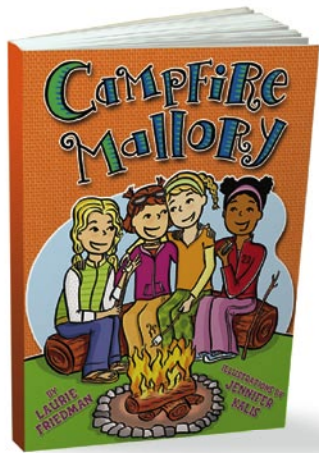

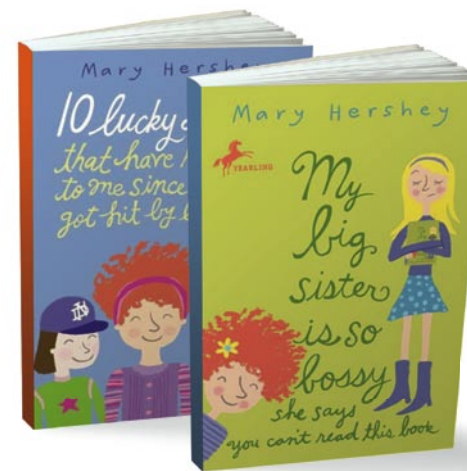

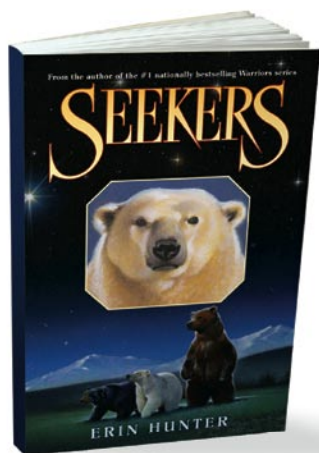


**SVETLANA GRIMM AND

By turns vicious and funny, SPIDER is a compelling and harrowing ride into the cheap thrills and high costs of car crime.



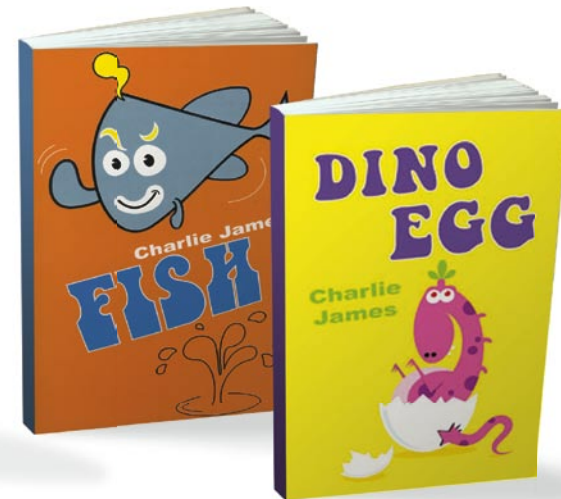
IN BAD FAITH

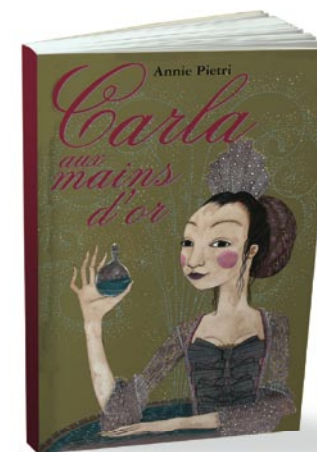
EMPRESS OF THE ETEREOS *Laura Gallego Garcia*
